


Talks to enrich our awareness by Mount Roland Land Care

Seven months of observations have allowed this new MRLC project to reveal species not previously known to be on the mountain. Kristen will share not just the footage she has collected but also her deepening sense of the life we're surrounded by, life we can, by Todd's example, help to protect.
